

## Dominica

The first law on environment in Republic of Dominica, known as the Law on Environment and Natural Resources (LEY 64-00) was passed in 2000. Under the Law, several environmental standards have been established. Emission standards for air pollutants from fuel combustion and industrial processes are set in Environmental Standards on Air Quality and Air Emissions Control.

### *Standards for emissions of particulate matter from coal-fired power plants*

plant type	plant size, MW	emission limit value, mg/m <sup>3</sup>
existing plant	< 50	250
	50 to 200	175
	> 200	150
new plant	< 50	175
	50 to 200	150
	> 200	120

### *Emission standards for SO<sub>2</sub>, NO<sub>2</sub> and CO from coal-fired power plants*

plant type	emission limit value, mg/m <sup>3</sup>		
	SO <sub>2</sub>	NO <sub>2</sub>	CO
existing plant	2600	300	1150
new plant	1100	250	1000

- Note:
1. 'Existing plant' refers to power plants that commenced operation before this Regulation came into force.
  2. 'New plant' refers to power plants that commenced operation after this Regulation came into force.
  3. Emission limit values are expressed as at 25 °C and 101.31 kPa.
